the City of London in the month of March  
One thousand eight hundred and sixty two  
and has issue of such marriage two  
children

That he has been resident in England  
for the last Ten years and has now a settled  
place of residence at No 6 Cable Street in the  
parish of Saint Mary Whitechapel in the  
County of Middlesex where he has resided

for the last Seven years and  
upwards

That he intends to reside  
permanently in the United Kingdom

That your Memorialist seeks  
to obtain the rights and capacities  
of a Natural born British subject  
because he has contracted for the  
purchase of certain freehold houses  
for the sum of Three hundred  
pounds and because he intends to  
reside permanently in this country

Your Memorialist therefore  
humbly prays that he may  
receive a Certificate of  
Naturalization to entitle him  
upon taking the Oath  
required in such case to  
the rights and capacities of  
a Natural born British  
subject

That we have been informed and believe that the said Louis Rosenberg is a native of Senczicz in Poland - That he is married and has two children.

That he has a settled place of residence at No 6 Cable Street aforesaid in which he has resided more than seven years and that he has been in England as we have been informed and verily believe for about ten years.

That he has contracted for the purchase of certain freehold houses for the sum of three hundred pounds and that he is in all respects a fit and proper person to receive the rights and capacities of a natural born British subject.

And we further severally say that each of us is a British born subject and a householder and that neither of us is the Agent or Solicitor of the said Louis Rosenberg.

And we severally make this solemn

Declaration conscientiously believing the same to be true and by virtue of the provisions of an Act made and passed in the Session of Parliament of the fifth and years of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the fourth intituled "an Act to repeal an Act of the present Session of Parliament, and intituled an Act for the more effectual abolition of Oaths and Affirmations taken and made in various departments of the state and to substitute Declarations in lieu thereof and for the more entire suppression of voluntary and extra-judicial Oaths and Affidavits and to make other provisions for the ~~abolition~~ abolition of unnecessary Oaths.
